## Accessibility Conformance Report

**Name of Product/Version:** EdReady -- Student View (Version 1.68)

**Product Description:** EdReady is a math and English readiness system that employs a low-stakes knowledge inventory to personalize a learner's path to subject mastery within the context of a specific goal. EdReady is a web application.

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**Notes:** Based on several third-party accessibility audits, including by [WebSavvy](#) and [Accessibility Shield](#), we have resolved all known accessibility issues and we believe EdReady meets ADA requirements and WCAG 2.0 A and AA guidelines. We are committed to maintaining our compliance and have incorporated accessibility-validation as part of our regular development and release processes; however, accessibility bugs may still be found, just as non-accessibility-related bugs may still be found. NROC staff will address any reported issues ASAP upon discovery. Furthermore, at NROC we view accessibility improvements as an ongoing process, and we will continue to work toward providing the best experience possible for all students based on feedback from our users and any changes to the criteria themselves.

**Evaluation Methods Used:** Conformance to the listed accessibility standards has been evaluated by third-party specialists using a combination of static analysis tools and manual testing with assistive technologies. Follow-up internal testing was evaluated by manual testing with assistive technologies.
