

## Sequenced Scopes

#### **Sequenced Scopes**




Also allows you to control the scope display order!

#### **Sequenced Scopes**

When a scope is locked, students can gain access by:

- Reaching target score of previous scope (optional can be disabled)
- 2. Entering the unlock code
  - important: the same code unlocks all scopes in the sequence
- Instructor can unlock via their login



#### **Sequenced Scopes: Setup**

Set up your goal, including Adding Scopes, then open the **Goal Options** tab

- 1. **Enable** Study Path Sequence
- 2. Indicate the scope display order
  - Select checkbox for any scopes that should be *locked* by default
- 3. Unlock next study path automatically
  - If enabled, students can unlock the next scope in the sequence automatically by hitting the previous scope's target score
- 4. Provide a **Manual Unlock Code**: can be typed into student's study path to unlock



#### Unlocking Scopes as an Admin User



- Edit EdReady Version (from reports dashboard)
- 2. Open the **Students** tab
- 3. **Edit** the students
- 4. Open the **student's Goals** tab
- Click on View Study Paths link for the goal the student is working in (will be in the top table, Assigned Goals)
- 6. Here you can **Unlock**/ **Lock** study paths for this student



## Study Path Options


Access and Test Settings

#### What is a "Study Path"?

**Study Path**: a specific scope in a specific goal

Can edit how the study path will function for students.


Allows flexibility for different scopes in the same goal to have different settings and messaging.



#### **Study Path Options: Access**

#### Option 1: Study Path Options tab


- Find the goal of interest & click the View Study Paths link
- Find the scope of interest and click the Configure link



#### **Study Path Options: Access**


#### **Option 2: Goals Tab**

- Edit the goal of interest
- Open the goal's Scopes tab
- 3. Click on the **Configure** link to access that scope's study path options settings



#### **Study Path Options: Test Settings**

Study Path Options provide additional customization for how the study path functions for students.




#### **Study Path Options: Test Settings**

## For most settings you will use default values, but there are some settings you may want to enable:


- Enable Unit Tests Allow or remove student access to unit level tests in their study path
- Allow students to hold questions until the end of the diagnostic- When enabled, students can come back to questions they hold, allowing a second chance to respond before completing the diagnostic
- **Skip Initial Diagnostic** Allow students to work through all topics and learning objectives in their Study Path. Students will begin with an EdReady score of 0.

#### **Enable Unit Tests**


Unit Tests are available by default. Enable Unit Tests must be checked in order for students to test at the Topic Level and have a Unit Test available.












## Study Path Options

Messaging

Provides the ability to customize most on-screen pop-up messages and create new ones triggered by specific events or criteria



#### Test Intro Messages


Can be used to provide specific guidance for the diagnostic and unit/ topic tests

- Calculators allowed?
- Can embed a video!



#### In-Diagnostic Messages

Can be used to provide encouragement and progress details to students while completing the initial diagnostic

- Multiple messages can be added: will display at selected percentage completion.
- Can display different messages to students based on their performance.
  - Students that are not performing well can be given the option to skip the remainder of the test
  - Any skipped Learning
     Objectives get a score of 0 (not mastered)



#### **Post-Diagnostic Messages**

Displayed immediately upon completion of the test activity. Can display different messages to students based on their performance.

- Diagnostic: can unlock next study path if score threshold is met
- Unit & Topic Tests: can display Learning Objective mastery

#### You have tried all of the problems on this topiclevel test. However, not all of your answers are correct. You have NOT mastered the required material.

You need to click on the *Learn* button for this topic to improve your mastery of this material.

#### Post-Diagnostic Messages: Topic Test Attempt Messages

- Can display after x# of Topic Tests for any Topic
- Will display only once (when test threshold is met for that topic), but can have messages for different numbers of tests

#### Steps to enable:

- Edit the Post-diagnostic / End Of Topic message
- 2. Click the **Attempt Messaging** button
- Can Add new messages or Edit/ Delete existing messages




#### Coming this Fall: EdReady Notifications
