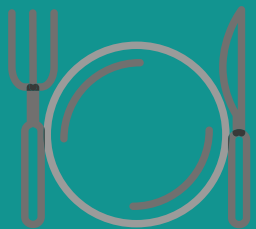
AS AN ORGANISATION

Provide materials such as cutlery, grocery bags, cups, bottles, etc for employees to borrow and return to reduce their need to ask for disposable ware from vendors and stores



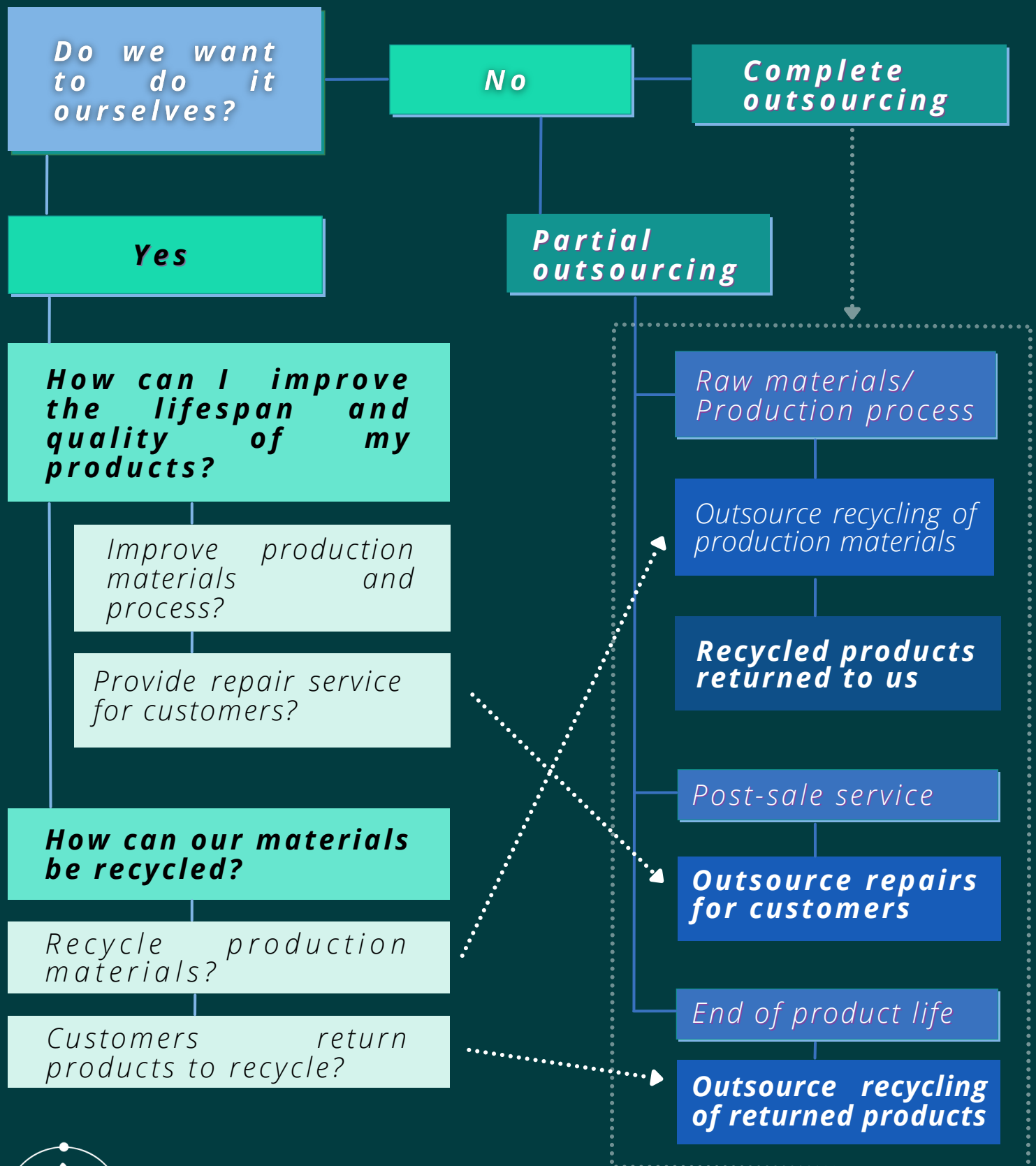
LONG-TERM STRATEGY
