CSS Adds Professional Dance Instructor to Community360 Day Program

As the Community360 Day Program celebrates its first year of completion, the curriculum shows no sign of getting stale. The latest addition is a Tuesday afternoon dance class led by Vincent Tufano, a professional dancer and founder of From the Heart: We 2 Can Dance, a dance program for individuals with disabilities.

Vince developed muscular dystrophy in the middle of his career and has used a wheelchair for eight years. Although the disease has immobilized his legs, it has not dampened his spirit. He continues his passion for dancing, and now channels his energy into encouraging people with disabilities to achieve what they set their

minds to.

Vince has repeatedly defied the odds while accomplishing some great things. He is the Chicago Ambassador for the Abilities Expo, teaches dance at other nonprofits, such as Shriners Hospital, and he's no stranger to hard work. In 2017, Vince won the Chicago Triathlon in the wheelchair division. He also competed, and took First Place twice, in adaptive rowing competitions.

"We are so grateful that Vince has joined us, he has made all the participants feel comfortable and have fun in an inclusive environment," says Mario Martinez, Director of Family Support, who oversees the Community360 program.

Vince knows that dance can do so much. Dance improves function and gives individuals an outlet to express themselves.


