- Excellent equitation, position and presentation; meets all fences squarely and at a proper 90 – 100 distance; Uses all options to their advantage.
 - Minor equitation faults, i.e. long, weak distance, deep distance, one step landing at 80-89 counter canter; Exhibitor still maintains a quality ride.
 - More problems occur, equitation suffers, i.e., rounded shoulders, heels are not down, hands incorrect, lacks the style and presence. One major fence problem, i.e., chip with a 70-79 ride up the neck, discreet swap out or jumping off one side of jump. No dangerous fences but not a flowing course.
- Major equitation faults, poor body position, loose legs and seat, failure to obtain or 60 - 69maintain trot to a trot fence approach, 2 or 3 misses at the fence.
- Breaking to a trot while on course, counter canter or cross canter ends of arena, missed lead changes, loss of stirrup, drop a rein, extra stride in combination.
- 10 39 Exhibitor avoids elimination, one or two refusals, knockdowns, dangerous fences.
