Applications must be postmarked by **April 19, 2024**.



### **General Information**

- Open to any graduating high school senior who is a current 2024 member of the POAC (family or youth membership) and who is actively showing POAs at the state, regional, and/or national level.
- Applications are to be typed or printed legibly. Essay and summary of educational goals must be typed. It is to the applicant's advantage to submit a complete, neat, legible, and informative application.
- Selection will be based on POAC activities, school and community activities, scholastic achievement, and information provided in the essay and in the summary of educational goals.
- Letters of recommendation are required from 1) a POA member, 2) a teacher, and 3) another person of the applicant's choice. Recommendation letters cannot be from a relative of the applicant. The person writing the recommendation should mail or email the letter directly to the POAC Scholarship Chair.
- Applicants must complete, sign, and return the application and supporting materials to Diane Kamps, POAC Scholarship Chair. All application materials must be received by or postmarked on or before April 19, 2024.





### **Additional Requirements**

Essay and summary of educational goals must be typed, double-spaced, and use Times New Roman 12 pt. font.

- **1. Essay.** Write a 300-word essay about you and your involvement with POAs and the POAC. The essay should include, but is not limited to, how long you have been involved with the POAC and what you have gained or learned during that time. You may include how your parents encouraged you, but please do not include information about your parents' involvement with the POAC.
- **2. Summary of Educational Goals.** Write a brief summary (150 or fewer words) about why you want to continue your education.
- 3. Official High School Transcript.
- **4.** Three Letters of Recommendation. Letters of recommendation from 1) a POA member, 2) a teacher, and 3) a person of the applicant's choice. Recommendation letters cannot be from a relative. The person completing each letter of recommendation should mail or email it directly to Diane Kamps, POAC Scholarship Chair.

A brief summary, 150 words or fewer, about why you want to continue your education	on	
School Achievements	20 points	
Grades, extracurricular and/or community activities		
Letters of Recommendation	20 points	
Required from 1) a POA member, 2) a teacher, and 3) another person of your choice		
Application	20 points	
Neat, complete, attention to grammar, spelling, etc.
