

About the Supporting Successful Transition module

Supporting Successful Transition is a three-session professional learning experience that will assist schools and educators to put in place robust processes to ensure the successful transition of students with disability and additional needs between school contexts.

In addition to conceptual knowledge around transition, participants will be introduced to the *Guide to Transition*, a collection of tools and templates to plan for and track transition.

The module will include case studies and illustrations of practice in which educators are successfully using the included tools to develop consistent and widely understood transition processes.

Finally, participants will be able to access support from experienced consultants to advise around their transition planning.

What is covered in each session of the module?

Session One is entitled **Understanding Transition**. In this session participants learn about the impact of a student's disability or additional needs on their transition journey.

Session Two is entitled **Transition Planning**. In this session, participants learn a six step process to put in place robust transition planning, and see how schools are effectively implementing these processes.

Session Three is entitled **Tools to Support Transition**. In this session, participants work with the provided templates to make specific planning arrangements for the students in their school identified as needing additional support. During this session, experienced consultants will work with individuals and small groups to problem solve and provide advice designed to facilitate successful transition.
