Seven Key Observations

- 7.) There are many **kings** on the list, but **God Himself is the true King**.
- 6.) **Saul (#4)** is covered extensively to illustrate the failings of human kings.
- 5.) **David (#2)** is mentioned often in the N.T. because the Messiah came through his line.
- 4.) **Abraham (#7)** is mentioned often in the N.T., because he was a man of faith (Rom. 4:3).
- 3.) **Moses (#3)** is mentioned often in the N.T., to help explain the relationship between the law and grace.
- 2.) There are **few New Testament people** on the list, because the N.T. focus is far more on Jesus than on his disciples.
- 1.) **Jesus** is #1 by a wide margin, because He is God the Son, the King of kings, the Way, etc. (See the list of his ranked titles.)

Caution

A few people may have been overlooked.

Although great care has been taken in compiling and correcting this list over the course of several years, a few people who are mentioned in the Bible six times or more may have been overlooked.

Do not overlook the unranked people.

Some well-known people, including Luke, Nehemiah, Nicodemus, the Philippian jailor, and Zacchaeus, are not included in this list, because they are mentioned five times or less. They are in the alphabetical listing however.

Who is Ranked Higher?

Game & Quizzing

(Top 383 List or Alphabetical List)

The leader or someone else (if taking turns) who has *The Bible Top 383 List* picks two people from the list and asks someone (or a team) who is not looking at the list to guess which of the two is mentioned more in the Bible (i.e. is ranked higher).

If the person / people being questioned do not know the Bible well, the questions asked should be basic. For instance, most people would be able to correctly guess that David (#2) is mentioned more in the Bible than Goliath (#84). It would be much more difficult to correctly judge between Goliath (#84) and Judas (#79) however.

Points: one point is awarded for each correct answer if the question is simple, involving a large ranking difference such as between David and Goliath. If the question is difficult because the rankings are fairly close, then two or three points may be awarded.

After an answer is given and points are awarded, the leader should ask about and / or talk about why one person (David, for instance) is ranked higher than the other (Goliath). *David is mentioned far more because he served God for many years, but Goliath was an unbeliever and did not serve God.*

If the two Bible characters are closely ranked (such as Judas #79 and Goliath #84), the leader may ask about or talk about why they are mentioned about the same number of times and rarely or often according to the case. *Both Judas and Goliath were evil and the stories that they are in are more about someone else (David and Jesus). So neither of Judas or Goliath is mentioned very often.*

Game & Quizzing

(Jesus' New Testament Title List)

Type A Questions:

The leader who has *Names and Titles of Jesus List* may **pick two titles from the list** and asks someone (or a team) who is not looking at the list to guess **which of the two is used more** in the New Testament.

If the person / people being questioned do not know the Bible well, the questions asked should be basic. For instance, most people would be able to correctly guess that Jesus' messianic title "Christ" is used many more times than his "Rock" title which is only used four times.

However, many would have trouble if the question were about Jesus' titles as "the First and the Last" which is used three times and "the Way" which is used only once.

Type B Questions:

Since about half of Jesus' many titles are only used **once, twice, or three times**, the leader or the players in turn may ask questions like this. "How many times was Jesus' title "Advocate" (which means lawyer) used? Once? Twice? or Three times.

Points: one or two point is awarded for each correct answer depending on the difficulty.

After an answer is given and points are awarded, the leader should talk about the title or titles in the question.

Jesus was often called "Christ" which means Messiah or anointed One, and this is why those who believe in him were soon called "Christians (Acts 11:26). They were not called "Rockians," since the title "Rock" was not used much. — Moreover, Jesus was called a "Stone" more than "Rock" because to those who disbelieved he became a "Stone of stumbling."

CAUTION 1

It is important to remember that this list of Jesus' titles only includes those used in the New Testament. Jesus is referred to as "My Servant" several times in Isaiah, but these usages are not counted. Only the one in Mat. 12:18 is.

CAUTION 2

This game is best used with those who know the Bible fairly well. Unlike most other games in this booklet, it is too difficult for most children.

Game & Quizzing

(Top 383 List or Alphabetical List)

The leader or someone else (if taking turns) who has *The GOD's VIP book-let* picks two people from the list and asks someone (or a team) who is not looking at the lists to guess which of the two is mentioned more in the Bible (i.e. is ranked higher).

If the person / people being questioned do not know the Bible well, the questions asked should be basic. For instance, most people would be able to correctly guess that David (#2) is mentioned more in the Bible than Goliath (#84). It would be much more difficult to correctly judge between Goliath (#84) and Judas (#79) however.

Points: one point is awarded for each correct answer if the question is simple, involving a large ranking difference such as between David and Goliath. If the question is difficult because the rankings are fairly close, then two or three points may be awarded.

After an answer is given and points are awarded, the leader should ask about and / or talk about why one person (David, for instance) is ranked higher than the other (Goliath). *David is mentioned far more because he served God for many years, but Goliath was an unbeliever and did not serve God.*

If the two Bible characters are closely ranked (such as Judas #79 and Goliath #84), the leader may ask about or talk about why they are mentioned about the same number of times and rarely or often according to the case. *Both Judas and Goliath were evil and the stories that they are in are more about someone else (David and Jesus). So neither of Judas or Goliath is mentioned very often.*
