## Who is Ranked Higher?

### Game & Quizzing

(Top 383 List or Alphabetical List)

The leader or someone else (if taking turns) who has *The GOD's VIP book-let* picks two people from the list and asks someone (or a team) who is not looking at the lists to guess which of the two is mentioned more in the Bible (i.e. is ranked higher).

If the person / people being questioned do not know the Bible well, the questions asked should be basic. For instance, most people would be able to correctly guess that David (#2) is mentioned more in the Bible than Goliath (#84). It would be much more difficult to correctly judge between Goliath (#84) and Judas (#79) however.

**Points:** one point is awarded for each correct answer if the question is simple, involving a large ranking difference such as between David and Goliath. If the question is difficult because the rankings are fairly close, then two or three points may be awarded.

After an answer is given and points are awarded, the leader should ask about and / or talk about why one person (David, for instance) is ranked higher than the other (Goliath). *David is mentioned far more because he served God for many years, but Goliath was an unbeliever and did not serve God.*

If the two Bible characters are closely ranked (such as Judas #79 and Goliath #84), the leader may ask about or talk about why they are mentioned about the same number of times and rarely or often according to the case. *Both Judas and Goliath were evil and the stories that they are in are more about someone else (David and Jesus). So neither of Judas or Goliath is mentioned very often.*
