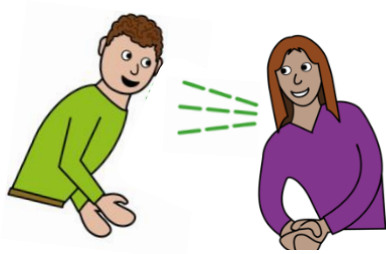

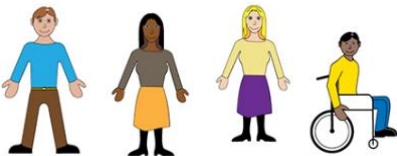
Disabled Peoples Organisations Australia



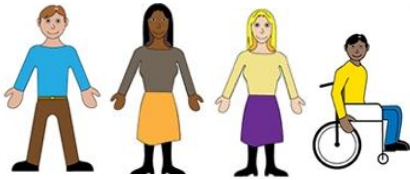
WWDA is a member of Disabled Peoples
