To be a transparency for infinite Intelligence and divine Love means to recognize that the carnal mind, this mesmeric influence of two powers, is not power, is not functioning in your or my experience, and has no law of God to maintain or sustain it. The realization of these principles instantly begins to operate as a freeing influence in our consciousness.

...Omnipresence! To dwell in the realization of Omnipresence is a form of prayer. It is acknowledging the presence of God where we are: heaven or hell, death, whatever or wherever it may be. It is acknowledging that there is only one Power, and that the appearance, however frightening its aspect, is not a power. Therefore, let it go on appearing. Since it is not a power, we do not try to get rid of it. We do not try to overcome it. We do not try to resist it. We acknowledge Omnipotence: "God is omnipotence. Omnipotence is within me, and there is no power external to me." We disregard the appearance, and our prayer, which is the recognition of Omnipotence, is answered. Prayer is a recognition of the word "Omniscience."

...Remember that the error is not a thing, nor a condition, and it is not a person. So in setting up that resistance, you are almost creating the thing you are resisting. In spiritual healing, recognize that error does not exist as a reality, no matter in what form it appears—sin, disease, lack, or limitation. When the problem is presented to you, do not resist it, do not deny or affirm it, but take the attitude of "non-resistance," a "divine indifference"—not putting up a mental wall against it, not trying to overcome it, not trying to deny it. Let your attitude be one of freedom from fear, a realization that you do not have to resist a mirage, that you are not going to separate tracks or lift the sky off the mountain. It is as if Jesus were facing a man with a withered arm and saying, "Stretch forth thine hand." What would make it possible for him to say that to a man with a withered arm, or to the cripple, "Arise, and walk?" It could only have been because his whole life had been a continuous recognition that there was

nothing to hinder this man; there was no presence or power in the arm or leg or in the back that had anything to do with his rising and picking up his bed and walking.

...Your consciousness remains just what it always was, only now instead of believing that the sky sits on the ocean, and the sky sits on the mountain, now you look out and you say, "Oh no, education destroyed my ignorance on that subject." In other words, I have died to those beliefs. But it isn't a dying process; it is a letting of those ignorances die out of your consciousness, so that into your consciousness may be borne the truth.
