Joel on "The New Horizon"*

...I remember this happened—my wife remembers this, and Miss Steves remembers this: I went to sleep one night in the home in Santa Monica, and I had a dream, and in this dream a red silk banner was lowered from the ceiling. On it was a message in old English lettering, a gold lettering, and I knew that I was dreaming and I knew that I had to awaken to get that message; I fought myself awake, and when I was awake that banner was still there, and I wrote down on my pad the message that was on that banner; when I was through the banner rolled itself up and went away. The next morning I gave that copy to Miss Steves, and she said, "Oh, that's the last chapter of the book—that's the New Horizon. And that is the chapter in *The Infinite Way*, 'The New Horizon." And that's how "The New Horizon" came into existence, through a message delivered in just that manner—word for word—just as it was written on that red silk. I tell you these experiences because my entire life, since 1928, has been made up of these experiences, and every step I have taken on the spiritual path has been under just that much direction, and just as personal, and just as intimate. And the reason for saying that now, and

I never have in any previous class, never have at any previous time, the reason I give you that now is that all this week I have been saying that it becomes our duty and privilege to know the nature of God, and I would like everyone to turn within themselves, and find within themselves that center, that place where God shines through, where God becomes a friend, a father, a mother, a protector, a guide, a councilor, and then life will begin to have a meaning, and a cosmic pattern of your life will be revealed.

... For the serious student, the most important chapter in *The Infinite Way* is "The New Horizon," because in it can be found the explanation of the reinterpretation of what you behold. In other words, this chapter explains clearly that the entire human picture is mesmeric suggestion, and it is this suggestion of a selfhood apart from God that you are called upon to reinterpret. After you have practiced this for a while, it becomes automatic for you, as you see people and events, to translate or reinterpret them, and then you really see them as they are without any mental gyrations.

... For those who seek to understand clearly the spiritual sense of life, the chapter "The New Horizon" in *The Infinite Way*, sometimes called "The Practitioner's Chapter," is the most important writing in the entire message. Most people are not so much interested in the spiritual sense of life as they are in enjoying a harmonious physical sense of life. A harmonious physical sense of life is very pleasant and, of course, it

is much more comfortable than an inharmonious sense of physical life. But we, as students of The Infinite Way, should not be satisfied merely with a physical sense of health because, regardless of what degree of harmony we may be experiencing today, it all can be changed by tomorrow. We are making the transition, as rapidly as possible from the physical sense of health to the spiritual sense of health. And with the spiritual sense of health comes the discovery that health is not dependent upon the organs and functions of the body—health is not dependent upon God alone, because it is a quality and an activity of God!

... Study well the chapter "The New Horizon" in *The Infinite Way*. Never let this chapter get stale. Never neglect this chapter. Now, you can never get un-hypnotized as long as you are judging by appearances, because the thing you are judging with, the human mind, is a state of hypnotism.

This is without any question of doubt, not only the deepest lesson of the message of The Infinite Way, it is the one I give seldom—probably not more than four times in eight years have I given this lesson, and then not in just this way. But this is the lesson of the

chapter, "New Horizon." This is the lesson on healing, because if you are able to heal spiritually without knowing this lesson, you will be very apt to lose your healing gift eventually because it engenders a blind faith or a faith in a personal gift, whereas spiritual healing has nothing to do with either blind faith or with a personal gift. ...It is not that The Infinite Way would build up in anyone a fear of error in any form, but it would hold up the nature of error to our view, so that we can look it right in the face, and then say to it, "Aha! I've seen you; I know what you are; and I shall no longer fear you, for now I understand the meaning of God's allness. It means the absolute nothingness of you, you appearing as sin, disease, or death." In our advanced work, such as The Thunder of Silence, the practitioner's chapter, "The New Horizon," (chapter 11, The Infinite Way) and in any of the teachings that I have given to practitioners, I have brought forcibly to the attention of our students that behind all the discords of the world is a mass hypnotism, not a hypnotism from one individual to another but a mass mesmeric sense that binds us. It is not a subject that is easily understood. It is difficult to understand how there can exist a mesmerism that binds us of which we are not even aware. When we are free of that hypnotism we can see the world as it is; and when we are not free of it, we can see it only from a hypnotized standpoint.

... Now, it is only the fourth-dimensional consciousness of the Christ that can say to the crippled man, "What did hinder you?" It is only the fourth-dimensional consciousness of the Christ that can say to the storm, "Be still." Don't think you are going to teach some young student to say it, and then they're going to go out and demonstrate it. Don't think you are going to demonstrate it except in proportion as you have worked with these principles so much. Now, this is why I have so often referred to this list of our writings: "The New Horizon" in The Infinite Way; "God Is One" in Living the Infinite Way; "Protection" in the 1955 Letters (The Heart of Mysticism, Volume Two); "Break the Fetters that Bind You" in the 1958 Letters (The Heart of Mysticism, Volume Five); "Contemplation Develops the Beholder" in the 1961 August Letter (The Contemplative Life); and then on the subject of human relationships, the "Introduction" to Practicing the Presence and "Love Thy Neighbor"; and the chapter "Relationship of Oneness" in The Art of Spiritual Healing. Why do I keep referring to those over and over again? Because if you work with those specific writings, apply them to the problems of life that come to you in your own experience or your family or your patients, if you work with them over and over they will develop fourth-dimensional consciousness.

... The thesis of equality has survived these 200 years, but to far too many, equality is a myth or wishful thinking. Not so to Infinite Way students. It is our privilege and duty to make the dream of the Founding Fathers no longer a dream of visionaries but an actuality. How? Every day, let us have meditation periods in which we recognize God as individual being and each individual as expressing all the divine qualities without limitation. Any barrier to that expression and fulfillment of our divine destiny is but a belief in twoness: a belief in two powers which constitutes the carnal mind, a universal mesmerism. But can the son of God, God individualized, be a victim of the carnal mind or of a universal mesmerism? Impossible! Our daily realization of these truths will help to lift the unequal burdens of human consciousness and reveal the freedom, expansiveness, and glory of spiritual identity. ... Everywhere on the globe the spiritual dynamite, the activity of the Christ, is breaking up the evil patterns of government, the evil patterns of man's relationship to man. It is breaking up man's domination of man, and it is doing it in the only way in which we can accept it. If we, The Infinite Way students of the world, if we were in the topmost positions of government, the transition could take place without all of this dynamiting, without all of this bombing. In the same way that you, individually, can make a transition from your material sense of self to your Christhood, without being dynamited out of your skin, without being dynamited out of your home, without being dynamited out of your savings or investments, you can make the transition gradually, but this is the price: you have to be willing to live a life of love. You have to be willing to surrender judgment, criticism, condemnation. You have to be willing, even when you witness the iniquity of people—and you can't help witnessing it, because it exists on the human plane—but you have to be willing to say, "Ah, yes, there is nothing personal about that. You have to be willing to forgive seventy times seven, and you have to be willing to pray for your enemy.

...God, Christ, prayer, meditation, communion—we use all these words but in a different sense, and this makes it difficult to perceive the message of The Infinite Way. Therefore, we have to make a transition in consciousness, and this takes time and effort.
