Distributor's notes

An orange wine made from 100% Trajadura, grown organically from vines planted in 2008 on granite, quartzite & schist soils in the Vinho Verde region of Northern Portugal. Grapes are hand harvested, must is fermented in contact with the grape skins and seeds and macerates for 7 months (in stainless steel). Aging continues for 6 to 12 months in used French oak barrels before being bottled. No fining, filtering, and very low SO2 at bottling (~30g/L).

Every wine they make has a minimum of 2 days of maceration on skins before pressing, foot pigeage, fermenting with indigenous yeasts only (the oranges in lagar and stainless steal and the whites in oak), after pressing they remain over the lees and no racking is made to take them off, no bâttonage and no filtration, stabilization, collage or clarification is made. No products are used to correct the wine or to alter it. All dry-farmed vineyards with a heavy focus on sustainability and biodiversity - they have an orchard of more than 100 fruit and nut trees, as well as many other native tree species scattered around, such as oaks, cork oaks, planes, pines, olive trees among others, in total more than 1,000 trees on their land.
