

Distributor's notes

There are 2 wines under the "Nomos" label, this is the blended one - Trajadura & Alvarinho. Every wine they make is hand harvested, has 2 days of maceration on skins before pressing, foot pigeage, fermenting with indigenous yeasts only in neutral French barrels. After pressing they remain over the lees in the same neutral oak for 6-12 months depending on vintage. No racking is made to take them off, no bâttonage and no filtration, stabilization, collage or clarification is made. No products are used to correct the wine or to alter it with the exception of a tiny amount of SO2 at bottling (~30ppm).

All dry-farmed vineyards (5ha planted to vine on a 15ha total property) with a heavy focus on sustainability and biodiversity - they have an orchard of more than 100 fruit and nut trees, as well as many other native tree species scattered around, such as oaks, cork oaks, planes, pines, olive trees among others, in total more than 1,000 trees on their land.
