Distributor's notes

Sourced from 20 year old trellised vines of Carménère in Lolol, a microclimate in the Colchagua valley. The grapes are dry farmed, hand harvested, spontaneously fermented in stainless steel with native yeasts, and continue aging in stainless-steel tanks through the spring. Bottled unfiltered, unfiltered, with only minimal SO₂ at bottling. This produces a much lighter and fresher style of Chilean wine than we're used to tasting. Only 12.5% alcohol. A total family-run project, including the label art made by the father. Production is around 9,000 bottles annually.

About the product

Color: Reddish purple with violet hues.

Aroma: The nose reveals a hint of herbal undertones and a strong scent of ripe, macerated cherries gently followed by a trace of green pepper with a chocolate touch.

Taste: Marked acidity and smooth tannins, fruity, with a bitter chocolate finish.
