Distributor's notes

Sourced organic fruit from 2 farmers with 100 year old Cinsault vines on granite soils in the Itata Valley and 100 year old Pais on clay in Maule. All vines are dry-farmed. The blend is 50/50 picked by hand and fermented separately. Cinsault is fermented in all stainless steel while Pais is fermented spontaneously in cement tanks, both with native yeasts. Fermentation continues through the following cool spring temperatures in the same tank and concrete. As with all of their wines they are bottled unfined, unfiltered with a touch of s02 at bottling only. The approach is to make a much fresher and lighter style wine from Chile, at a comfortable 12% abv. A total family project, even the label art is done by the father. Annual production is around 5,333 bottles.

About the product

Color: Purple color with ruby reflections, clean and transparent.

Aroma: With a fruity nose where red berries predominate.

Taste: Pleasant and easy to drink, with a good level of acidity that gives it freshness. The tannin is delicate, round and velvety.
