### Distributor's notes

This one has a pretty cool story. When winemaker Andres Carull bought this vineyard it was legally registered as being Garnacha - hence the label. After some analysis he discovered it was much more complex. This is a field blend of white/red/pink grapes - 40% Garnacha Peluda, 60% blend of different local varieties (Royal, Arcos, Tortosi, Valenci, Forcallat, and even a little bit of Saperavi).

Everything is grown organically on sandy limestone soils, hand harvested, co-fermented with native yeasts and partially whole cluster. Continues to age in amphora for around 6 months before being bottled unfined, unfiltered, and zero SO2.

### About the product

Intense purple color. Aromas of red and black fruits appear on the nose, including some floral notes. It has balsamic, esparto and dried leaf nuances as well as notes of baked clay and clay typical of the jar. In the mouth the wine is fruity, lively, cheerful and with a balanced acidity. It is a red wine with texture, medium body and a medium finish, which makes it ideal to drink accompanied by a wide variety of rice dishes, pasta and tapas.
