## Distributor's notes

A very special white wine made from 100% Vigiriega, organically farmed vineyards at 1,300 m altitude over poor and stony slate soils. Grapes are hand harvested, destemmed, and direct press. Wine ages in used French oak barrels for around 10 months. Unfined, unfiltered, and no added sulfites. Annual production is 1,300 bottles.

La Vigiriega was a grape recovered from extinction by Manuel Valenzuela (founder, winemaker) in the year 1983 and thanks to this today it is the most widely planted in the entire region. However, when being outside the DO (their wines aren't officially registered) the variety cannot be mentioned on the label. But if you look at it, the initials of the adjectives that describe it at the bottom of the image form the grape's name. Also in the same sassy way of "V for Vendetta" ;-)
