Distributor's notes

Hang on to your hats, this is a lot of wine! All dry-farmed Cabernet Sauvignon grapes from 4 ha of organic vineyards planted on clay and quartz soils only 30 kilometers away from the sea. The vines are around 20 years old and found in the Lolol, a microclimate in the Colchagua Valley. The grapes are hand harvested, fermented in stainless steel with native yeasts, aged nine months in stainless-steel tanks (without any contact with wood) and bottled unfined, unfiltered with very minimal SO2 at bottling. While this wine packs a "Pacific Cab" punch, the idea is to keep it much lighter than usually found from Chile. 100% a family project and all label art is painted by their father. Annual production is around 5,000 bottles.
