



 - June & July 2018: Negative

- Samples collected from two locations
- Sampling performed monthly Jun Sep
- Analysis includes: Total Phosphorus, Chlorophyll-a, and Secchi depth

 - April 21, LSLID board approved moving forward at conclusion of Public Information Meeting
 - County proposed alternative to LSLID (May)
 - LSLID briefed project at the May LCIA meeting
 - ** Met with LSLID June 1st
 - Received reply to LCIA questions 18 July
 - County surveyed all Shamineau owners (July)
 - County notified LSLID survey results 7 Aug






Lake Shamineau High-Water Study

- Results of Meeting on 1 June with LSLID
