## Numberblocks Castle

## What you need:

- 1 shoebox
- 4 rectangle boxes
- Cardboard sheets
- 1 sheet of black paper
- Double-sided tape
- Safety scissors
- Pencils
- Cube shapes to draw around


## What you need:

(1) Starting with your shoebox, place a rectangle box on each corner. Measure and cut out each rectangle to fit over each corner of your shoebox. Use your double-sided tape to stick and secure your castle towers.
(2) Take your cubes or a ruler and draw the battlement design for the top of your towers. Measure the bottom of each battlement and make 3 cuts of equal distance to fold into a square.
Use double-sided tape to stick your battlement square to the top of your towers.
(3) To create the walls of your castle, take 4 sheets of cardboard and measure the battlement design on each 1 . Make 2 cuts on the left and right sides and fold them into rectangles. Stick them to the sides of your castle.
(4) Using your cubes, measure and cut out your door frame. Stick your frame to the front of your castle. Using the inside of the door as a stencil, cut out the entrance by cutting through the shoebox at the top and sides only. This will create the castle bridge.
(5) Measure the length of 1 cube and cut out enough squares to cover the outside of your castle.
