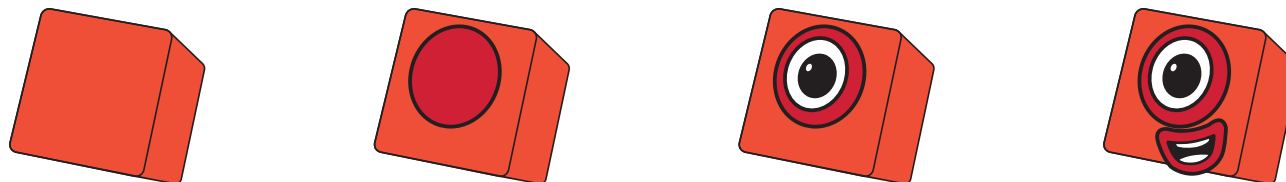

# Let's knit Numberblock One

**KNIT KIT**

**Yarn:** Stylecraft Special DK, shades (A) 1010 Matador, one 50g ball, (B) 1123 Claret, (C) 1001 White, (D) 1002 Black, small amounts

**Needles:** 3mm**Sturdy card:** min 18cm x 24cm**Ruler****Masking tape****Safety toy stuffing****Tapestry needle****ABOUT THE YARN**

**Stylecraft Special DK** is a premium acrylic yarn that is non-allergic and knits to a standard DK tension. There are 100 shades to choose from, making it an extremely popular choice for toys and more. It has an RRP of 2.60 per 100g (295m) ball. **NEED AN ALTERNATIVE?**

**Cygnat Superwash DK** is a pure wool yarn that is naturally soft and well-suited to toys that may endure a bit of rough-and-tumble during playtime. It comes in over 25 fresh shades so there is plenty of choice. It has an RRP of 2.75 per 50g (104m) ball. For stockists, visit [cygnetyarns.com](http://cygnetyarns.com)

**BODY**

Using 3mm needles and yarn A, cast on 52 sts

- Row 1 (WS): p17, k1, p16, k1, p17
- Row 2: k to end
- Rows 3-21: rep Rows 1-2 nine times, then rep Row 1 once more
- Row 22 (edge): cast off 17 sts, p17 for edge, cast off to end. 18 sts
- Rejoin yarn A to rem sts ready to work a WS row
- Rows 23-42: starting with a p row, work in st st for 20 rows

- Row 43 (edge): k to end
- Rows 44-63: starting with a k row, work in st st for 20 rows
- Row 64 (edge): p to end
- Rows 65-84: starting with a p row, work in st st for 20 rows
- Cast off

**EYE**

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on 36 sts

- Row 1 (RS): (k4, k2tog) three times, (k2tog, k4) three times. 30 sts
- Change to yarn C

- Row 2: p to end
- Row 3: (k1, k2tog) five times, (k2tog, k1) five times. 20 sts
- Row 4: p to end
- Row 5: (k2tog) to end. Ten sts
- Cut yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

**PUPIL**

Using 3mm needles and yarn D, cast on 18 sts

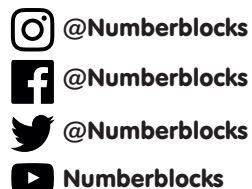
- Row 1 (WS): (p2tog) to end. Nine sts

- Cut yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off

**MOUTH**

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on 20 sts, change to yarn D

- Row 1 (RS): (k3, k2tog) twice, (k2tog, k3) twice. 16 sts
- Cut yarn, thread through rem sts, pull tight and fasten off



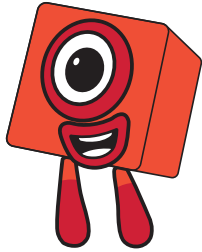

### LEG (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on 12 sts

- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (k1, kfb) three times, (kfb, k1) three times. 18 sts
- Rows 3-7: starting with a p row, work in st st
- Row 8: k7, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1. 16 sts
- Rows 9-11: starting with a p row, work in st st
- Row 12: k6, k2tog, k5, k2tog, k1. 14 sts
- Row 13: p to end  
Cut yarn B, leaving 30cm tail and separate the plies. Cut a 30cm length of yarn A and separate the plies. Create colour blend by holding together as folls

- Row 14: using two plies of yarn B and one ply of yarn A, k to end
- Row 15: using one ply of yarn B and two plies of yarn A, p to end  
Cut yarn B and change to yarn A (all three plies)
- Row 16: k5, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1. 12 sts
- Row 17: p to end
- Row 18: k4, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k1. Ten sts
- Cast off

### ARM (make two)

Using 3mm needles and yarn B, cast on 12 sts

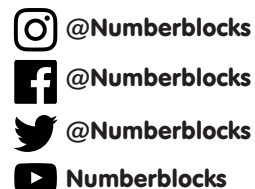
- Row 1 (WS): p to end
- Row 2: (k1, kfb) three times, (kfb, k1) three times. 18 sts
- Rows 3-5: starting with a p row, work in st st
- Row 6: k7, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k1. 16 sts
- Row 7: p to end  
Cut yarn B, leaving 30cm tail, separate plies. Cut a 30cm length of yarn A, separate plies. Create colour blend as folls:



- Row 8: using two plies of yarn B and one ply of yarn A, k to end
- Row 9: using one ply of yarn B and two plies of yarn A, p to end  
Cut yarn B and change to yarn A (all three plies)
- Row 10: k6, k2tog, k5, k2tog, k1. 14 sts
- Row 11: p to end
- Row 12: k5, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1. 12 sts
- Row 13: p to end
- Row 14: k4, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k1. Ten sts  Cast off

### ABBREVIATIONS

**beg** - beginning  
**cont** - continue/s  
**DK** - double knitting  
**foll(s)** - following/follows  
**k** - knit  
**k2tog** - knit two stitches together  
**kfb** - knit into the front and the back of next stitch  
**min** - minimum  
**p** - purl  
**p2tog** - purl two stitches  
**patt** - pattern  
**pfb** - purl into the front and the back of next stitch  
**rem** - remaining  
**rep** - repeat  
**RH** - right-hand  
**RS** - right side  
**st(s)** - stitch(es)  
**st st** - stocking stitch  
**tog** - together  
**WS** - wrong side



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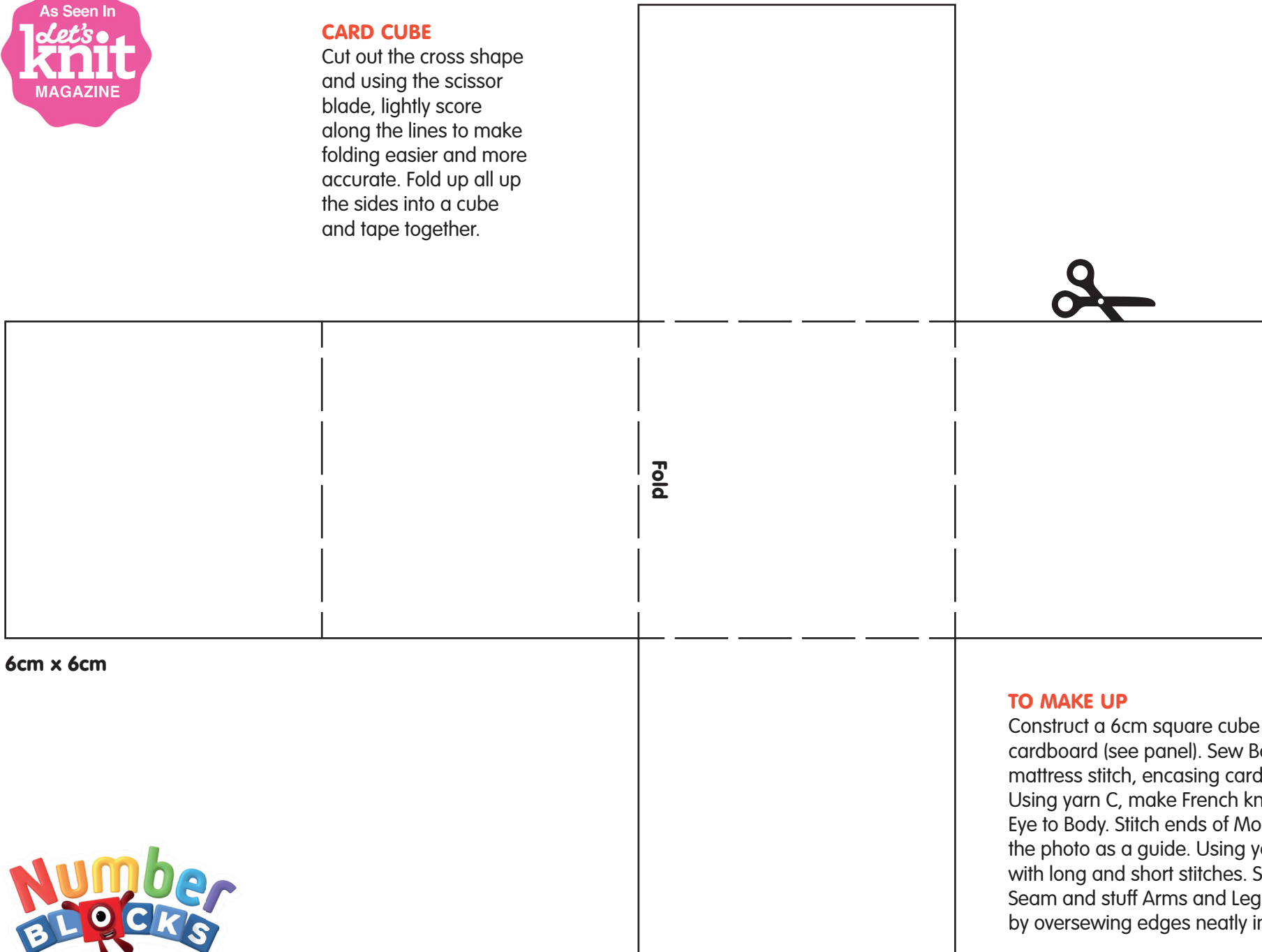

### CARD CUBE

Cut out the cross shape and using the scissor blade, lightly score along the lines to make folding easier and more accurate. Fold up all up the sides into a cube and tape together.



6cm x 6cm

### TO MAKE UP

Construct a 6cm square cube with sturdy card or cardboard (see panel). Sew Body seams using mattress stitch, encasing card box. Sew Pupil to Eye. Using yarn C, make French knot inside pupil. Sew Eye to Body. Stitch ends of Mouth, shaping by using the photo as a guide. Using yarn C, embroider teeth with long and short stitches. Sew Mouth to Body. Seam and stuff Arms and Legs. Attach limbs to Body by oversewing edges neatly in yarn A LK.
