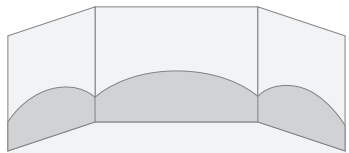

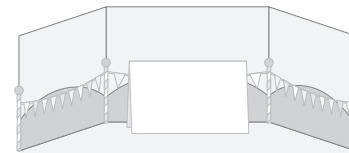
Here's how to make your own story!



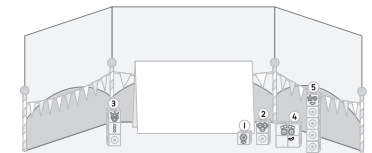
1. Create a backdrop for your story by taping three pieces of A4 card together. Then colour in a hilly background to look like Numberland.



2. Follow the instructions on pages 2 and 3 to build the bunting and bunting poles.



3. Follow the instructions on page 4 to assemble the scene. Then using your MathLink Cubes build Numberblocks One to Five.



4. Look what One can do! Use stampoliner One to make every big shape up to 5. Use your MathLink Cubes to help make different shapes.

Bunting poles

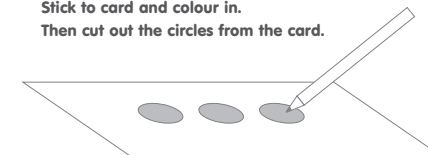
A. Cut out the poles along the dashed line and colour in...



B. Roll the cutout along the longest edge. Tape together to make a cylinder...



C. Cut out the circles along the dashed lines. Stick to card and colour in. Then cut out the circles from the card.



Bunting

A. Colour in and cut out the bunting below.

B. Cut out 3 pieces of string 23cm long.

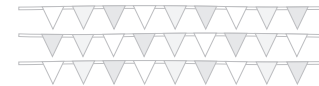


C. Put glue on the bunting on the side that is not coloured in.

Place 9 bunting in a line and stick the string down the middle like this.

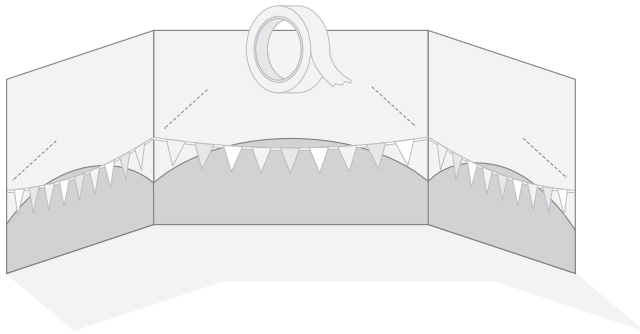


B. Fold the bunting in half sticking the 2 halves together with the string in the middle. Make 2 more.

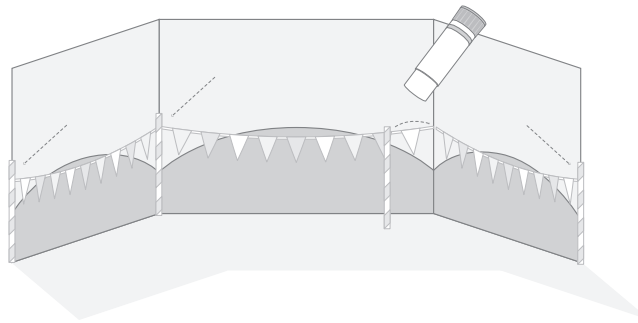


Assemble

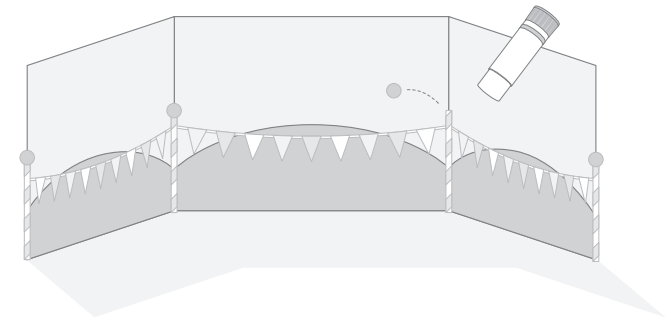
A. Using tape, stick the bunting to the edges of each sheet of cardboard.



B. Stick the bunting poles to the edges of each sheet of cardboard.



C. Stick the circles to the top of each of the bunting poles.



D. Stick a piece of A4 paper to card and fold in half to create the stampoline display
