## Play Together

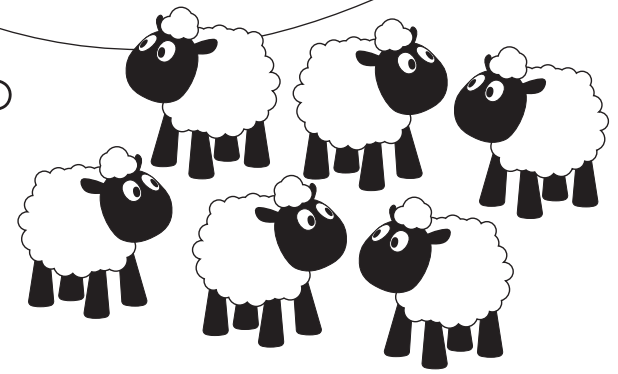
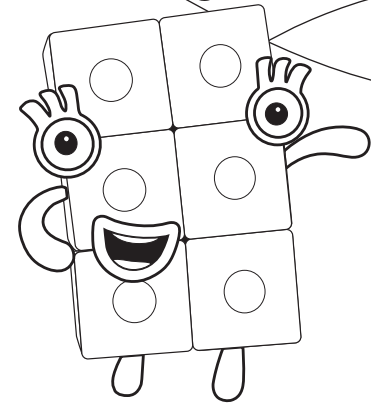

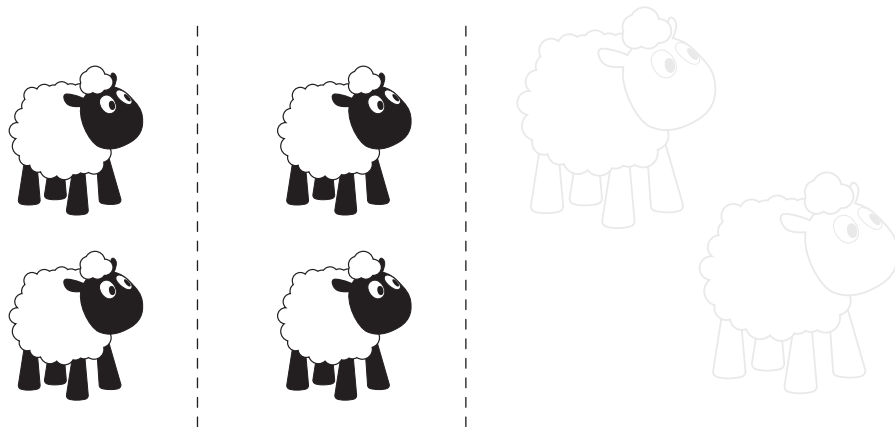

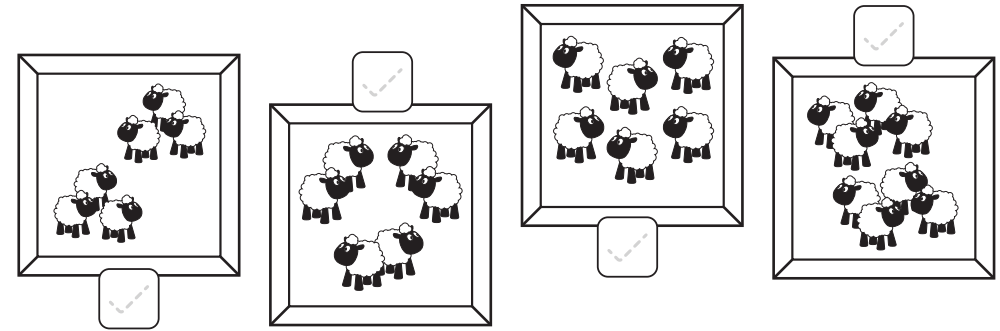
One lot of sheep is missing!

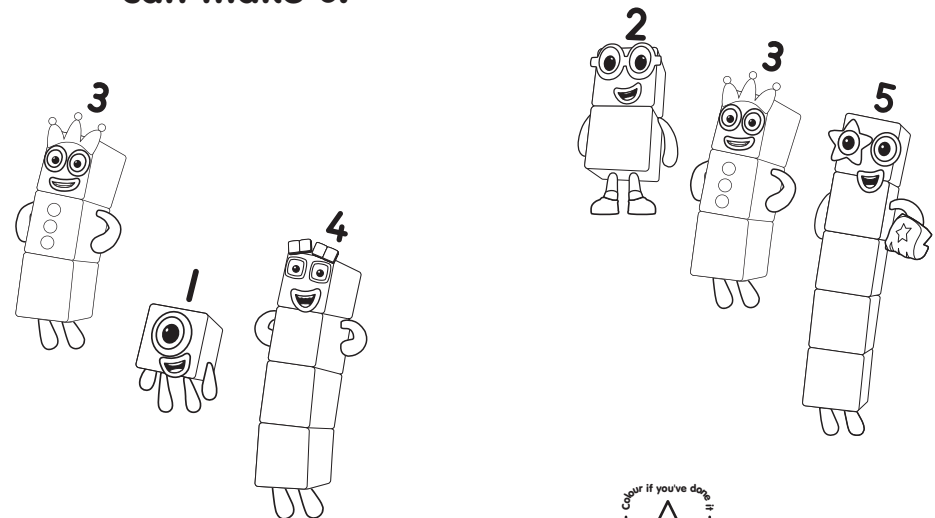
