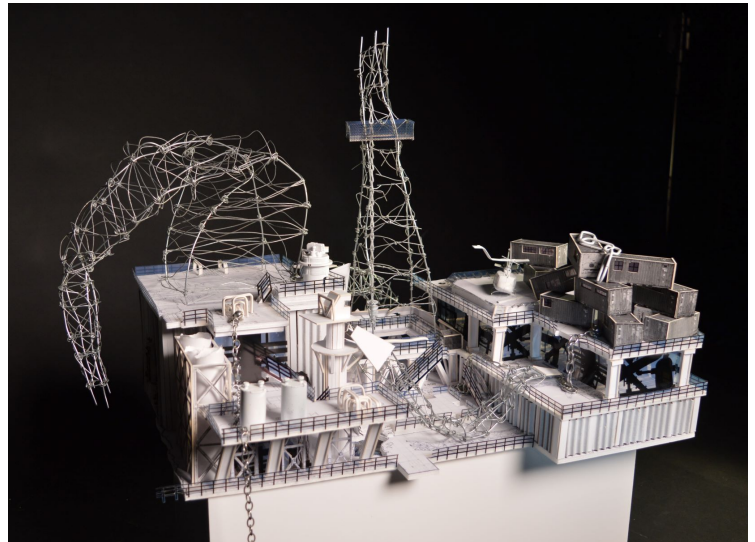


# ELOISE PERRY

## BA (H) DESIGN FOR FILM & TV



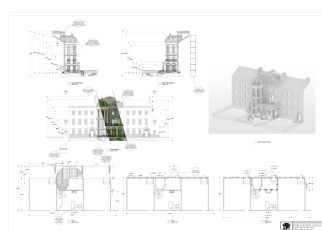
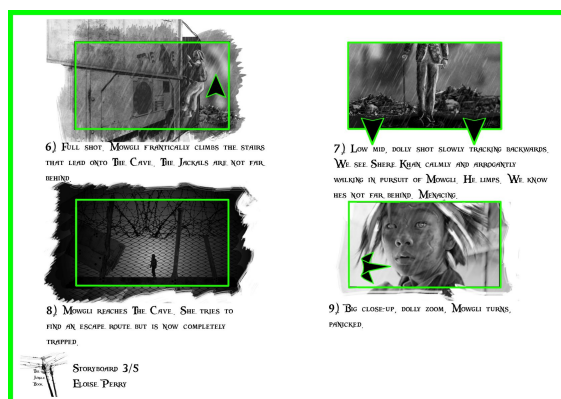
