

Plimmerton BC Operational Requirements under the COVID-19 Protection Framework

MY VACCINE PASS CHECKPOINT Access to the club grounds will only be available to sailors and one supporter or coach for each Starling sailor.

Sailors and those coaches and supporters can access the rigging zone once the My Vaccine Pass has been confirmed or official exemption has been checked.

Children under 12 yrs and 3 months are exempt but must still register. Only then can they access the rigging zone. My Vaccine Pass Checkpoints will be stationed at the front gate. Each zone will be clearly marked. Refer to site layout on page 4 and table below. Please go to your specified class zone to get registered as soon as you arrive.

Registration stations will be open from 8:00 am Saturday morning. There will be a regatta QR code at each station that you must scan before registering. Classes are allocated to rigging zones if we have over 40 boats entered as follows: Blue Zone and Green Zone

WHEN YOU REGISTER:

- You must first scan the regatta QR code that will be available at each zone.
- You must provide proof of vaccination status
- You will be given a coloured wristband that you must keep on for the duration of the event.

YOU MUST AT ALL TIMES

- Not come to the club if you are experiencing any flu-like symptoms and advise the regatta organizers.
- Leave immediately if you do start to experience flu-like symptoms and advise the regatta organizers.
- Always wear a mask when on the boat club site (but not while sailing)
- Maintain 1.5 meters distance between you and other competitors

BOAT CLUB ACCESS

The boat club building has a 100 person limit.

BOAT WASHDOWN There will be at least 3 washdown areas

SIGNING ON AND OFF You must sign on/off with the Ramp Marshal. Signing on will be contactless. Say clearly to the Marshal your sail number you are, and they will mark you off as signed on or off. He/she will not come looking for you; it is your job to find him/her.

OFFICIAL NOTICEBOARD Will be outside the slipway shed

CAR PARKING. No cars are permitted to park on the boat club grounds. There is public parking outside the club grounds

TRAILER PARKING Trailers can be stored in the Yellow zones around the club compound car park.

SECURITY Boat Park security will be provided on Saturday night.

NON-REGISTERED SUPPORTERS Non-registered supporters are not to access the club site during the event. You can watch from Public areas adjacent to the club ground. There are public toilets beside the club grounds.

SUPPORT BOAT LAUNCHING AND RETRIEVAL Support boats can be launched and retrieved from the main slipway. Vehicle access will be given to allow launching of a support boat.
