3. Who is your favorite book hero? Who is your favorite book villain?
4. If you could travel into any book like Tilly, what book would it be and why?
5. When Tilly travels with Anne from Anne of the Green Gables, she takes Oskar with her. If you could take anyone with you on your bookwandering journeys, who would you bring with you?
6. Part of the magic in being a bookwanderer is you can take characters outside of their stories (though you'd be the only one who can see them). If you could choose, which character would you take out of their story? Why?
7. When she's reading and especially when she's bookwandering, Tilly feels all these different emotions—happy, excited, brave, and sometimes scared. Was the last book you read that made you feel all those things?
8. One of the rules of being a bookwanderer is you cannot travel more than five pages before the end of the book unless you've been trained in Endpapers Travel. Have you ever read the last page of a book before reading from the beginning?
9. If you knew you were going to be stuck in a story for a very long time, what are three things you would bring with you?
10. When Tilly is talking to Cheshire Cat from Alice in Wonderland, they talk about whether or not Wonderland is actually real or not. What would be one magical place from a book you wish were real?
