As I was saying to pretty much everyone that asked me how the pilgrimage was going: 'It's a lot to take in, but it's a relaxed atmosphere, which is nice.' The pilgrimage can feel quite busy at times, and even emotionally difficult. But everyone's there to help, and if you're like me and it's your first time then no wonder it's a very different experience!

"Of course, being a Young Helper gave me the chance to connect with other Young Helpers too! I didn't know how many friends I would make at first, but I managed to talk to everyone during the pilgrimage and could feel the support that was being shared. There were also many opportunities to talk to others about the pilgrimage, or your interests (on that note, the choir and the concert are both enjoyable if you like performing!), or even just have a laugh. I really enjoyed the spontaneous karaoke we had one night - it was great to see everyone enjoying themselves!

That mostly involved pushing pilgrims in wheelchairs. Like I said, you get more confident as you get used to everything around you. It makes a lot of difference to your experience, and it makes me glad that I decided to go. Oh, and Party Night. Can't forget that – it's definitely something to look forward to at your hotels.
