Home - Christchurch



Meet at the Whanganui Racecourse for a 7:45am departure and travel to Palmerston North Airport to catch our 10:10am flight to Christchurch.

We land and get straight into the Autumn colours visiting the beautiful **Monavale**. Christchurch City Council undertook a two-year, \$3.2m rebuild and strengthening project so the delightful Mona Vale Homestead could once again open its doors to the public.

Today the gracious Victorian building is once more resplendent in her heritage best In addition to the house and gardens, Autumn is especially a wonderful time of year to visit with the autumn colours in the gardens a standout.

On arrival, we will have the house tour and be given background on the property followed by a great lunch. We are then led through the wonderful gardens.

From here, it is just a short drive into the exceptional **Christchurch Botanical Gardens** where we climb aboard an electric vehicle and tour in comfort, exploring one of the



world's most historic Botanic Gardens allowing you to view some of the best examples of native and exotic flora in New Zealand.

We then head to our central accommodation where you will be given some time to refresh before heading back out for a very special dinner. This evening at 5pm, we are dining aboard the only **Tram Restaurant** in New Zealand which offers you a unique way to view the inner city of Christchurch while enjoying a delicious evening dinner.


After this amazing day of exploring, we head to our accommodation and then meet for a **lovely meal** to end a magical day out.

This stunning garden will blow you away with its varied themes and established trees, plants and flowers. Then its into Queenstown for some down time before **dinner**.

Saturday 20th April

Queenstown



After **breakfast** we meet our friends at Nomad Safari's and are treated to one of the best day trips Queenstown has to offer.

The **Skippers Canyon 4WD tour** departs from Queenstown heading out towards Coronet Peak. As you head up the peak towards the entrance to this spectacular canyon there are stunning panoramic views of the Wakatipu Basin.

After entering Skippers Canyon we will travel to Lighthouse Rock, which gives a dramatic lookout over the entire canyon. Follow in the footsteps of many adventurers and discoverers as this historical winding road brings you to the historic Skippers Bridge, which provides a stunning photo opportunity.

Carefully travelling over the bridge, the road continues into the historical township of Skippers. Long since abandoned, much of the original building still remains, waiting for you to explore it.

Indulge in morning or afternoon tea at the Skippers School building. Immerse yourself in the history of this stunning place as the restored school house divulges a wealth of information through photos and artefacts from the early days of this settlement. The cemetery nearby depicts a more gloomy and dangerous life for these gold prospectors.

Returning along the road we will stop at Deep Creek where you can immerse yourself in the heritage of the local area by turning your hand to a spot of gold panning. Our trained guides will teach you techniques to successfully pan for gold on one of the richest gold-bearing rivers in the world. Some may also recognise spots along the Skippers Road as being featured in The Lord of The Rings.



We'll get back into Queenstown where you'll have time to wander the town, do a spot of shopping of simply relax and put your feet up before another **superb meal**.

Sunday 21st April Queenstown - Alexandra



After **breakfast** ending a great 2 night stay in Queenstown its time to pack our bags and hit the road. A real treat in-store for us this morning as we weave our way around to Kingston and board the mighty **Kingston Flyer** which has only recently returned to service.

On September the 18th 2022, the Kingston Flyer held their Grand Opening Ceremony and celebrated the return of commercially run public train rides from Kingston to Fairlight.

After this trip down memory lane we board the bus and head for the wine region of Gibbston Valley where we stop for **lunch** and we sample of the local wines.

We continue our way to the quaint little town of **Clyde** where you will be given some free time to wander the main street and visit the shops of your choice.

It is then a short drive into Alexandra for a short tour of the famous landmarks before arriving at our accommodation for the night. We'll head out to a local restaurant for **dinner** then rest our heads for the night.

DAY 8

Monday 22nd April Alexandra - Oamaru



We'll relax again this morning and get underway cruising through some stunning countryside making our way to Moeraki where you have a chance to stroll the beach and view the boulders or simply relax in the cafe. We'll make our way out to the coast and check out the Moeraki Esplanade and the Whalers lookout before heading to the local tavern for a gorgeous **lunch**.

Its back on the bus after lunch and we make our way slightly north of Oamaru where we have a guided tour through the awe inspiring **Riverstone Castle.** Complete with moat and dungeon. Standing on its own island, the 1200sq m building has everything you would expect in a castle, including gargoyles, towers and arrow-slit windows. But there are also many surprises, from the carved cows decorating the exterior and the pink flamingos floating on the surrounding lake to the tiara perched on a "throne" inside and the ceiling constellation which lights up at night in the master bedroom. Explore the gardens following the tour. This will be an afternoon to remember. We head into our accommodation for a wee rest before we making our way to the **Blue Penguin Colony** where we have premiere seating and view these little guys coming home from a day out fishing - A really wonderful experience that will give you the warm fuzzy's. Once we've seen the penguins we'll head out for our final night **dinner** and raise a glass to an incredible tour. Note: Dinner will be a little later than usual tonight but worth the wait.

Sixteen commercial buildings in Harbour and Tyne Streets, in what is locally known as the Historic Precinct. Each of the buildings, built during the Victorian period, has it's own story, character and charm. We grab a bite to eat for **lunch** and then start making our way back to Christchurch in good time to catch our **6pm flight** back to Palmerston North. You can grab yourself an early dinner at the airport and the bus will be waiting to collect you to transfer you back home.


