After the noun “help”, the verb must come in its -ING form.

She needed **help cooking** dinner.

They didn't need **help coming** here

That sounds like

Used to describe something that seems appealing to the ears. The same structure can be used for other senses, and they all have “seem” as a synonym.

It sounds like a terrible idea.

It seems like a good plan.

It smells delicious.

It tastes heavenly.

It doesn't look good.

Which

The pronoun “which” is used here to connect two ideas (we have mac computers and is a very popular brand). Always use the pronoun which when you want to refer to something mentioned before.

We have the Edifier headphones, **which** have amazing sound quality.

We can watch Pride and Prejudice, **which** is my favorite movie.



One

Used to substitute a word already used in a sentence.

I love books by this author. I'll take **one**.

Which jacket do you prefer? I prefer the black **one**.
