(If your child normally eats a light breakfast, that routine should be followed during testing as well, rather than giving them a larger breakfast than usual, etc.)

Tax Statements are posted in your FACTS tuition account. To access your school tax statement, follow these steps:

Sign into your account and look for "Payment Plan & Billing" and click on "View Details." That will bring you to "Activity Details" and click on "View Payment Summary." Once in Payment Summary, you will see our school information and tax number to right of your name and address. Right under your name and address you will see a drop down box with the year. Drop down to 2021 and print your statement.
