RAFTS Writing Activity

Goals:

- Differentiate based on students' readiness, interests, and learning profile using the RAFTs activity during writing
- Provide specific parameters to engage the students in a more authentic experience

Steps:

- Create a matrix for students with the following headings: Role, Audience, Format, and Topic.
- RAFTs can be created based on the content of the units being taught at the time.
- You may either assign each student a strip of the matrix based on their needs or allow students to make their own choice based on their interests.
- Once students have been assigned, or have selected, a RAFT, they should begin writing based on the specifications of their RAFT.
