

# NJSLA Research Simulation Task Grade 3 Reading

### **Lesson 4: Identifying Supporting Details**

### **Rationale**

 To be successful on the NJSLA assessments, in addition to identifying main ideas, students will be required to identify supporting details in informational text, used to inform, describe, supplement, and emphasize the main idea.

#### Goals

 To prepare students for the reading assessment by teaching them strategies to identify supporting details.

### Task Foci

- CCSS RI.3.1: Ask and answer questions to demonstrate understanding of a text, referring explicitly to the text as the basis for the answers.
- CCSS RI.3.2: Determine the main idea of a text; recount the key details and explain how they support the main idea.

## **Objectives**

• Students will be able to identify textual evidence that supports the main idea.

### **Materials**

- Sample text from Lesson 3
- Main Idea worksheet from Lesson 3
- Supporting Details worksheet

### **Procedures**

- Tell the class that today they are going to work on finding supporting details.
- Using a sample passage from an informational text the class has read recently, model how to find a supporting detail by clearly identifying it and explaining precisely how it supports the main idea.
- Distribute the students' worksheets on main idea from Lesson 3 and have them re-read their statement of the main idea.

- Have the class re-read the text from Lesson 3. Then ask them, "Do you still think your statement of the main idea is accurate."
- Explain, "Whether the answer is 'yes' or 'no', today we are going to find evidence in the text that supports the main idea, and revise our main idea statements if we find that they aren't correct."
- Distribute the Supporting Details worksheet.
- Preview the worksheet.
- Give students 10 minutes to complete.
- Bring the class back together and discuss students' findings.

### **Assessment**

- Check that students correctly identified supporting details on their worksheet.
- Check that students revised their main idea statement to better reflect the text's main idea.
