

6 Shifts with the Science of Reading

How ready is your school to implement these evidence-based practices?

| 1 | Provide all students with dedicated systematic phonics instruction , not mini-lessons or isolated phonics instruction. |
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| 2 | Help students with phonics-based scaffolds, not three-cueing or word guessing. |
| 3 | Commit to phonological and phonemic awareness instruction, not isolated games or lessons. |
| 4 | Revisit high frequency word instruction using orthographic mapping , not memorization. |
| 5 | Use decoding assessments to assess which students are struggling with decoding, not assessments that evaluate if students are using meaning, syntax or visual (MSV) cues. |
| 6 | Use decodable readers, not leveled readers. |
