

2023 Changes to NJSLS Mathematics

1	Split the K-5 “Measurement and Data” domain into “Measurement” and “Data Literacy” domains to enhance data analysis and communication skills.
2	Introduced new standards in early elementary for word problems involving money to build conceptual understanding.
3	Replaced “fluency” with “accuracy and efficiency” throughout the standards to emphasize essential aspects.
4	Included middle school foundational work with radicals to prepare for advanced math courses, including rational and irrational number expectations in grades 6-8.
5	Designated additional standards that may be clustered into courses like statistics and data science as “plus” to guide students in data-based skills.
6	Increased opportunities for students to engage with authentic data sets through scaffolded and supported data exploration.
7	Inclusion of climate change opportunities within standards across all grade levels.
