In the "Manage Report Panel" dialog box, the tabs are not marked up as tabs.  In the "Manage Entry Saved Lists" dialog box, the functionality of the tabbed content in the left side of the dialog box is not clear.  Several dialog boxes do not contain the 'role' and 'ariamodal' attributes.

		Some dropdowns do not have the correct aria labels.
		In the "Account Information" dialog box, the button that adds a token does not have a name (or label).
		In the "Manage Entry Saved Lists" dialog box, pressing "Edit Saved List" in the options menu opens a second level dialog box "Edit Saved List / Edit (1 Record)". Closing this box does not reset the focus.
		When a profile photo dialog box is opened, the focus is correctly placed on the dialog box; however, when pressing the Tab or Shift + Tab keys, the focus moves from the dialog box to the underlying page content.
		For the "Show Only Selected" button, the state (pressed or not pressed) is communicated visually; however, it is not communicated via markup to screen reader users.
