## Workshop Presenters



Kyle Schiefelbein-Guerrero is the Steck-Miller Assistant Professor of Worship and Liturgy and Co-Director of Worship Life at United Lutheran Seminary in Pennsylvania. He is editor of the book *Church after the Corona Pandemic: Consequences for Worship and Theology* (Springer, forthcoming), convener of the Lutheran caucus of the North American Academy of Liturgy, and a founding member of the Global Network for Digital Theology.

Susan Briehl is a Lutheran pastor rostered in the Indiana-Kentucky Synod (ELCA), called to serve the wider church as teacher, writer and liturgist. She has served in team ministries as director of Holden Village, campus pastor at Pacific Lutheran University, and pastor of Our Saviour's Lutheran in Bellingham, WA and has taught parish worship and preaching at Wartburg Seminary. Most recently she has served as the associate director of the Valparaiso Institute. Her hymn texts include Holy God, Holy and Glorious, By Your Hand You Feed your People, To Christ Belong, and God Alone be Praised.



Her writing includes *On Our Way: Christian Practices for Living a Whole Life*, edited with Dorothy Bass (Upper Room), *Holden Prayer around the Cross* with Tom Witt (Augsburg), and, with Marty Haugen, *Unfailing Light: An Evening Setting of Holy Communion* (GIA). She lives in Spokane with Martin, who serves a Bishop of the Eastern-Washington-Idaho Synod of the ELCA. They have two grown daughters.
