## **Memorandum in Opposition**

S2126 - Senator Krueger A1536 - MoA Ortiz

An act to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to limitations on investments of public pension funds

## OPPOSE!

This bill, which would take effect immediately upon its enactment, would prohibit the Comptroller of the State of New York from investing Common Retirement Fund monies in publicly-traded fossil fuel companies. Further, it would require the divestiture of billions of dollars of funds currently held as solid investments in those companies.

The Comptroller of the State of New York, as sole trustee of the aforementioned monies, is charged with the fiduciary responsibility of ensuring the maximization of the Common Retirement Fund for the exclusive retirement benefits of its more than one million active and retired members and their beneficiaries. Any legislation that would in any way usurp the authority of the Comptroller would, in our opinion, be again deemed to be unconstitutional and not survive another court challenge.

Therefore, The New York State Public Employee Conference, an umbrella organization comprising more than 80 unions and groups representing public employees, strongly opposes this legislation, and urges its defeat.
