An Act to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to disability retirement for members of the department of environmental conservation, forest rangers, university police officers and the regional state park police

SUPPORT

This bill, which would take effect immediately, would allow members of the division of law enforcement in the department of environmental conservation, forest rangers, university police officers and the regional state park police, who are injured in the performance of duty and can no longer perform their duties due to the injury, to receive three quarters accidental disability retirement.

This legislation would correct an inequity in that New York State Troopers, as well as members of the New York State and Local Police and Fire Retirement System already are eligible to receive three quarters accidental disability retirement benefits.

The New York State Public Employee Conference, an umbrella organization comprising more than 80 unions and groups representing public employees, strongly supports this legislation, and urges its enactment.
