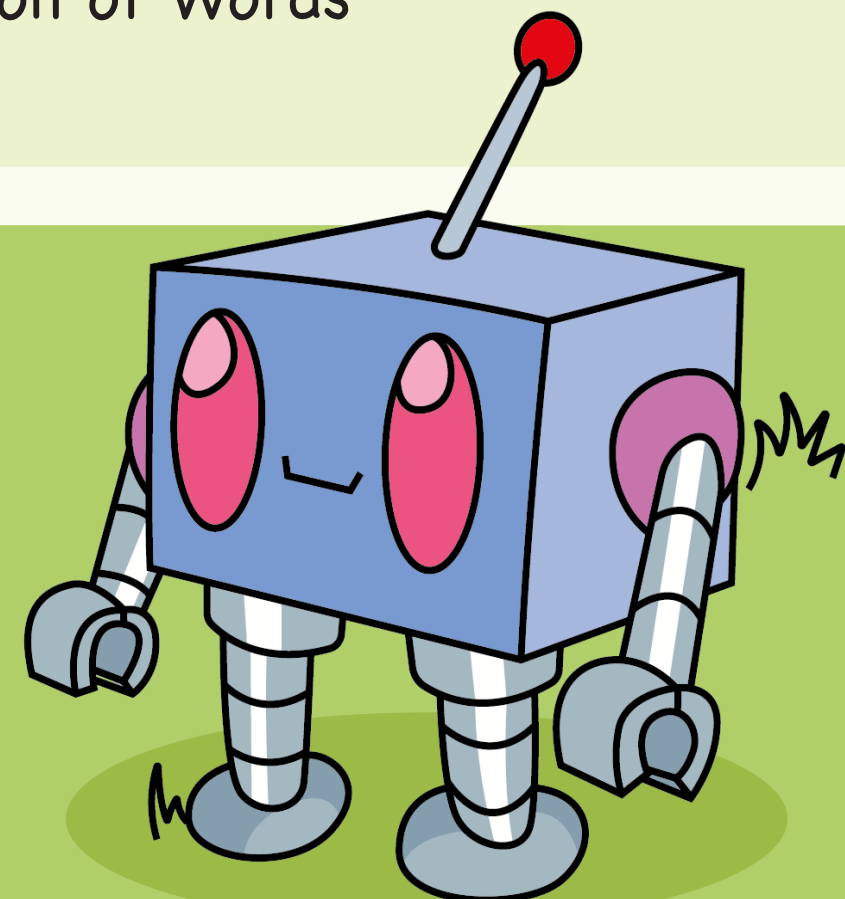

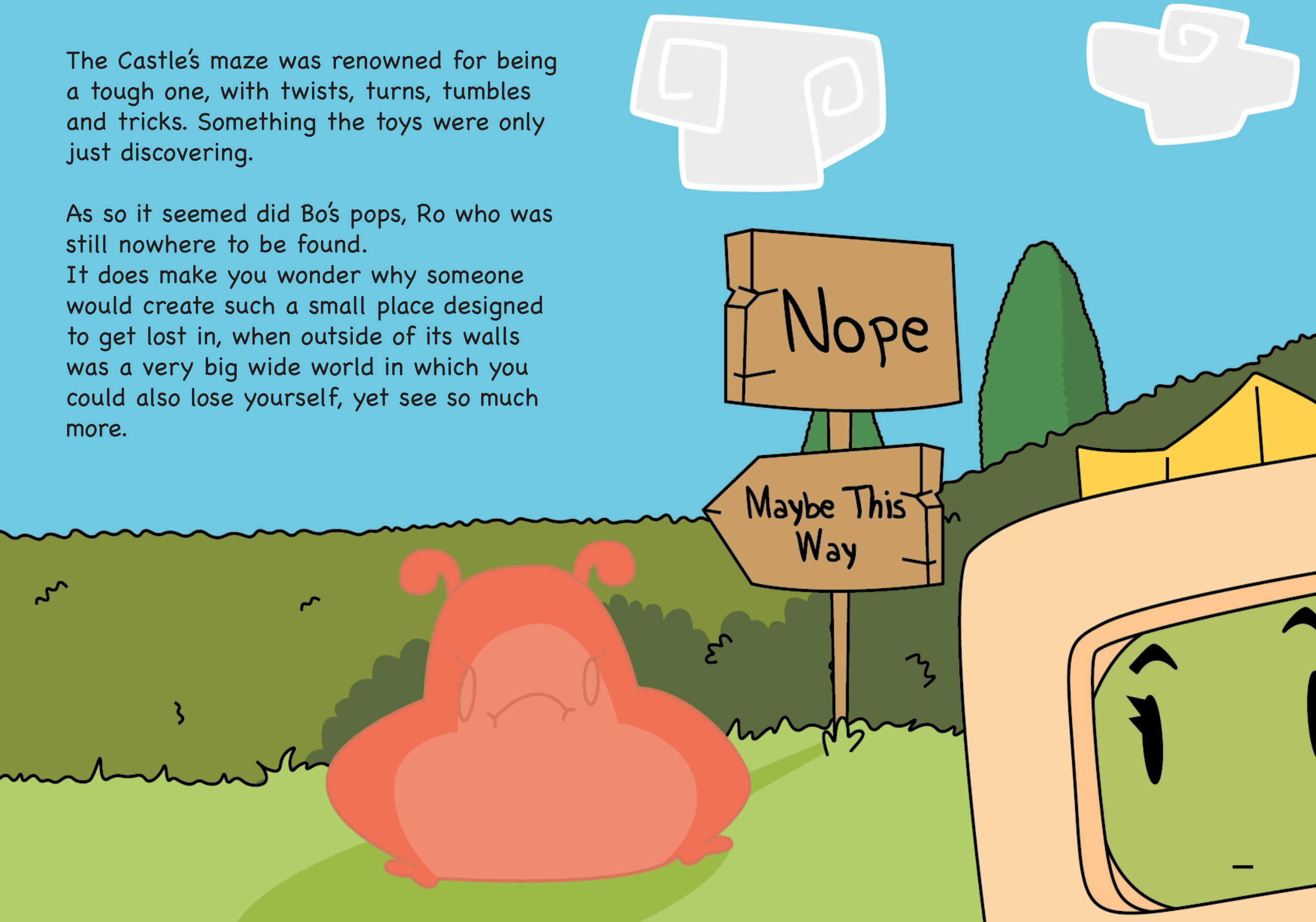

It does make you wonder why someone would create such a small place designed to get lost in, when outside of its walls was a very big wide world in which you could also lose yourself, yet see so much more.

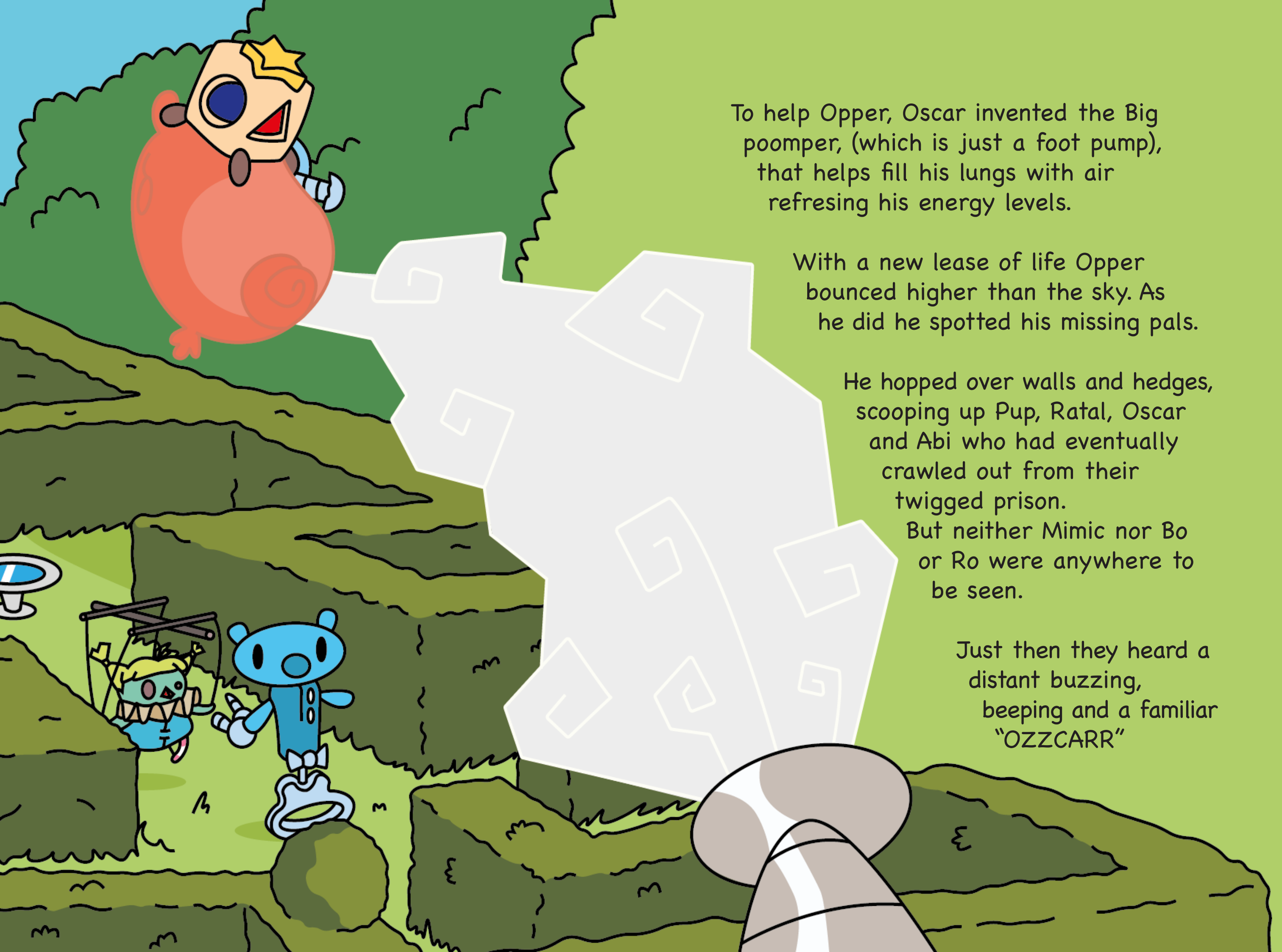


Ratal had a habit of rattling when he became anxious and Opper regularly found himself out of puff and in need of some fresh air.
