STARTING ACTIVITY - Introducing instructional writing (15 minutes) In preparation for the Big Write in Phase 3 introduce and discuss the topic of instructional writing. Discuss why we might use instructions and write them on the board. Discuss different types of instructions e.g. recipes, building/making something, how to do something. How do instructions help us? MIN TEACHING - Introduce the features of instructional writing (15 minutes) Explore and discuss the main features of instructional writing. The main features of instructions eign and use instructions, adverbs and prepositions, list of materials, chronological order, etc. MIN TASK - Explore different types of instructional (25 minutes) Allow students to work in groups. Students will be given a variety of different types of instructions in their groups. For example, a game, a recipe, washing instructions, instructions to build something etc. The students should work together to discuss the instructions and find the features of instructional writing throughout the various types of instructional writing.
