



Crown for a Friend Worksheet

TEACHER GUIDANCE SHEET

Required Material:

- ▶ The Crown for a Friend worksheet
- ▶ Pens / pencils

L.O:

- ▶ To identify someone who might need their spirits lifted.
- ▶ To know the importance of sharing kind words with others.

STARTING ACTIVITY (5mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – Together talk about things that the children admire about people they know. These people can be friends, family or their role models.

Have the children choose one person that they want to create a crown for, and then think about as many different things as they can to be featured on the crown. These could be personality traits or things that they have said or done that they think the world should know about.

MAIN TEACHING (10mins)

Ask the children why they think it is important to recognise things about other people that they admire, or specific traits that they like about them. Now ask them if they should share those things with the other person.

The children can then gift their crown to that person to lift their spirits, and if they would like they can wear it to let everyone else know how special they are.

PLENARY (2mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – Ask for volunteers to share their crowns with everyone else, tell them who it is for and why they chose that person.

Tell the children that whilst we shouldn't feel the need to compliment people all the time, we can certainly recognise when a friend or family member maybe needs a bit of a confidence boost. It could help them to feel better if we share with them something that we admire about them. Remind them of something good that they did or said and lift their spirits.

MAIN TASK - Crown For a Friend (15mins)

Tell the children that using the template on the worksheet, we are going to create a crown for a friend or family member that will feature all the nicest and greatest things about them.
