TEACHER GUIDANCE SHEET

STARTING ACTIVITY (5mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – With the children discuss what it means to be unique. Talk about who is unique and what makes them so.

MAIN TEACHING (10mins)

Following on from the group discussion you should have concluded that everybody is unique, and have some interesting suggestions as to what makes a person unique.

Tell the children that each and every person is a world unto themselves in the sense that the thoughts and experiences they encounter during their day to day lives will be entirely different from the next person. And this alone makes someone unique.

But we also all have elements of our personalities that are completely different. Whilst some of us may like the same music, or the same food, watch the same movies or play the same games, we also will have different and sometimes bizarre (in the eyes of others) tastes, interests or habits. But this makes us, us and we should be proud of those and feel able to proudly share them with other people.

This will be a short story about us that celebrates all that makes us unique and different that we can share with the world.

PLENARY (2mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – Ask for volunteers to swap poems with someone else and read each other's out to the rest of the children.

DID YOU KNOW!

Rome was founded by two brothers nursed by a she-wolf. The two twin brothers were named Romulus and Remus and were abandoned soon after their birth. They were discovered on the banks of the River Tiber, by a she-wolf, who took them in and fed them. Eventually the boys grew up to found a city.
