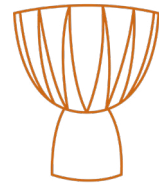

Flames of Change Worksheet TEACHER GUIDANCE SHEET

Required Material:

- ▶ The Flames of Change Worksheet
- ▶ Pens / Pencils

L.O:

- ▶ To understand what makes an ambition impactful.
- ▶ To think up different ambitions that could have a positive impact.

STARTING ACTIVITY (5mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – Together talk about how we can be ambitious whilst doing good for others. What makes an ambition a good one?

Tell them that they don't have to come up with complete ideas, just different things they could do that would make a positive change. Give them examples of giving food to the homeless, or planting trees to save the environment.

MAIN TEACHING (10mins)

Leading on from the group discussion, check that the children are comfortable with the meaning of the word 'ambition'. Then tell the children that having ambition is great, and having an ambition that could help others can be even better.

As a comparison see if the children can suggest what kind of ambitions might have a more negative impact. You can give them the example of someone driven by money at the expense of other people, or the environment.

But what if we did something that could benefit the world in one way or another.

PLENARY (2mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – Ask for volunteers to share some or all of their Flames of Change and explain why these are important issues.

MAIN TASK - (15mins)

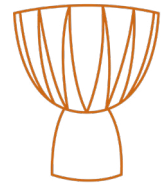

Then have them write these ideas into the little flames on the worksheet.
