TEACHER GUIDANCE SHEET

L.O:

STARTING ACTIVITY (5mins)

GROUP DISCUSSION – Together talk about building a positive network. What kind of people can have a positive impact on our lives? How do they make us feel? What qualities should we look for in our friends and mentors?

MAIN TEACHING (10mins)

Tell the children that having a supportive network can greatly influence our happiness and success. Surrounding ourselves with positive individuals can uplift us and help us grow.

Explain that positive people are those who bring out the best in us. They encourage and support us, making us feel valued and loved.

They inspire us to pursue our dreams and help us overcome challenges. Positive influences can be found in our family, friends, teachers, and mentors. Look for individuals who are kind, respectful, and empathetic.

Ask them how they think we could build a positive network. Tell the children that they could actively seek out people who share their values and interests. Join clubs, organisations, or community activities where you can meet like-minded individuals.

MAIN TASK - (15mins)

Tell the children that they could try and be more open to making new friends and forming meaningful connections.

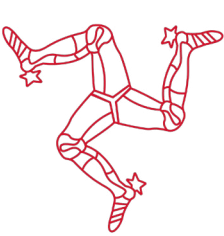
Using the template below, have the children think of a person for each section to build their network, that they can refer back to when they need someone for something in particular.
