
## 25 YEARS OF HOPE MISSION SAVE A CHILD'S HEART

## PROGRAM DETAILS& FEES

Cost: \$3998 Double Occupancy Single Supplement \$1667

Cost includes VIP meeting upon arrival, all programming, and hotels, 4 dinners and 5 lunches, famous Israeli breakfast every day, ground transportation with a guide.
Not included: Airfare, 3 dinners, 2 lunches, and tips.

\$500 per person deposit with remainder paid in full 30 days before departure.

Cancellation policy: Full refund up to 60 days, 50% 30 days out. COVID-19 Exception: If mission is cancelled due to COVID-19 pandemic, registrants can either receive a full refund or transfer their payments to a future mission.

Requests for cancellation must be made in writing. The mission is priced as a package and no refund or discount will be made for any part of the tour/activity in which you choose not to participate. In addition, no refunds will be made if you leave the trip voluntarily or involuntarily after the date of departure.
