Children are invited to bring a toy or game to share with their classmates on Monday. Please insure it is non-electronic and not of a high value.

IMPORTANT - INCREASING NUMBERS OF COVID CASES IN SCHOOL

We are noticing a sharp increase in the number of children testing positive for COVID presently. Although some of our positive children have had a raised temperature or cough, many cases do not. Those children are showing one or more of the following symptoms:

Headache	General unwell feeling	Sore throat	Runny nose	Sneezing
Nausea	Diarrhoea	Vomiting	Extreme ti	redness

We are asking that if your child has any one of these symptoms, you give them a lateral flow test. If your child has several of these symptoms, particularly a general feeling of being unwell or headache, we ask you take them for a PCR test and keep them at home until their result returns.

By following these requests, you are helping to minimise the chance of outbreaks in school and keeping vulnerable members of our community safe.

If you are reporting your child as ill, please tell the office the result of your child's lateral flow test when you report their absence.

IMPORTANT - MAKING THE SCHOOL AWARE OF NEW COVID CASES

If you discover your child has Covid following either an LFD test or PCR test, please ensure that you let a member of the office or senior leadership team know as soon as possible. Please do not use Class Dojo for this.

ON A VERY POSITIVE NOTE...AVA GIBSON

Ava Gibson, in Jaguar Class is doing something very special for a member of her wider family.

When Ava was watching the Pride of Britain Awards, she turned to her parents and asked if there was anything she could do to help Phoebe, a family member. Phoebe has dealt with two liver transplants whilst only being an infant. She has been in and out of hospital all her life and has just spent the last 6 months leading up to and following the last operation.

The first attempt at a transplant failed, but the second, from her Nana, has so far been a success. Phoebe's mother, Lauren, has obviously had a tremendously challenging time supporting her through this and Ava felt that she could help make life a little better for them both by raising a little money. Her target was £100.

Ava has been going out every evening, in all weathers, to run a mile or so with her dad and her dog. As word has spread of her commitment to carry on doing this, she has now raised around £1300 with other cash donations.

I personally think that this is a very impressive deed and shows how we can make a difference supporting each other.
