MESSAGE OF THE WEEK

EARLY YEARS & INFANT PACKED LUNCHES - SAFETY

TROPHIES AWARDED LAST TERM

SHOES & UNIFORM

Please ensure that your child attends school wearing black shoes. This does not include black trainers or any other type or colour of trainer. A small number of children are currently attending school each day wearing inappropriate footwear. The school will contact parents to request that correct footwear be delivered to school.

NURSERY TRIP

We are taking Nursery children on a trip to Windmill Animal Farm on Wednesday 23rd February 2022. This will be a whole day visit, we aim to leave school at 9.15am and return at approximately 2.30pm. The trip will cost £19.50 and payment must be made on Parent Pay. The cost of the trip includes entry to the farm, a train ride and the coach transport. Children will require a packed lunch for the trip. Full school uniform must be worn on the trip, as well as a waterproof coat, wellington boots and cold weather clothes (hat, scarf, gloves). Finally please can you ensure that you have completed and returned the 2021/2022 Medical Form, and that there are no changes to it.

SUPERMARKET VOUCHERS FOR ELIGIBLE FAMILIES

Free £15 Supermarket vouchers for eligible families – APPLY BY 4TH FEBRUARY

Over the February half term, all parents of school-aged children who are claiming their entitlement to free school meals will receive a £15 supermarket voucher per eligible child. If you are not currently claiming free school meals but you believe you may be eligible, please fill in this form to check your eligibility:

If you have more than one child in school, you will need to apply for each individual child. This is a simple and confidential process. If you prefer to speak to someone about registering, please call the LCC Pupil Access team on 01772 532109. Registering for Free School Meals does not mean that your child has to take a school meal at lunchtime. They can still bring in a packed lunch if you prefer, but the school will receive additional funding to support your child within school.

To ensure you receive your supermarket voucher for the holidays, please complete this form **before Friday 4th February 2022.**

School also receives Pupil Premium Funding for each child that receives free school meals. This funding is used in a variety of ways including catch-up groups for children who have fallen behind in Maths or English, additional 1:1 reading sessions or speech and language support. The more pupils we have that are eligible for Free School Meals, the more vital funding the school will receive to support children's learning and well-being.

YEAR 2 TRIP

We are taking Year 2 on an educational visit to Delamere Forest on Tuesday 26th April 2022. This will be a whole day visit. We aim to leave school at 9.00am and return at approximately 3.45pm. All children must wear wellies and have a dry pair of shoes and socks with them; we will be going outside even in the rain so please dress appropriately for the weather. School jumpers and appropriate trousers (no jeans), waterproof coats, hats and sun cream please.

Children will be provided with a packed lunch, you may also wish to supply an additional soft drink in a disposable bottle (no fizzy drinks please). The cost of this visit will be £13.75 and has been subsidised by the PTFA.

Please give consent for your child to attend by paying on Parent Pay and please ensure we have a completed up-to-date medical consent form as without this your child cannot attend. Forms were sent out last month, we are still waiting for some to be returned.

YEAR 3 TRIP

We have organised a trip to The Yorkshire Sculpture Park for Year 3 on Tuesday 26th of April. The cost of the trip will be £15 due to the coach costs, which have been subsidised by the PTFA. It can be paid via Parent Pay. A packed lunch will need to be brought, unless your child receives a free school meal. Children will leave at 9am sharp, returning to school hopefully by 4:15pm. We will keep you informed on our progress as we travel back, dependent on phone signal.


MAKING THE SCHOOL AWARE OF NEW COVID CASES
