#### PARENTS' EVENING- RECEPTION - YEAR 6

Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November- All appointments booked by parents on this day will be in person in school. Please only book an appointment on this day if you wish to have an in person Parents Evening in school.

If you choose to book a virtual appointment, please download Microsoft Teams in advance. An invitation will be sent out nearer the time on Class Dojo.

#### PARENTS' EVENING- NURSERY

Nursery's Parents Evening will be on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November only. Parents have a choice as to whether their appointment is in person in school or virtual via Microsoft Teams. We ask that you include in the comment section when booking whether it will be virtual or in school.

#### FREE SUPERMARKET VOUCHER FOR ELIGIBLE FAMILIES – APPLY BY 16<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER

Over the October Half term holiday, parents with a school-aged child claiming their entitlement to free school meals will receive a £15 supermarket voucher. If you are not currently claiming free school meals please fill in this form to check your eligibility:

If you have more than one child in school, you will need to apply for each individual child. To ensure you receive your supermarket voucher for the holidays, please complete this form **by 16<sup>th</sup> October 2022.** 

This is a simple and confidential process. If you prefer to speak to someone about registering, please call the LCC Pupil Access team on 01772 532109. Registering for Free School Meals does not mean that your child has to take a school meal at lunchtime. They can still bring in a packed lunch if you prefer, but the school will receive additional funding to support your child within school.

School also receives Pupil Premium Funding for each child that receives free school meals. This funding is used in a variety of ways including catch-up groups for children who have fallen behind in Maths or English, additional 1:1 reading sessions or speech and language support. The more pupils we have that are eligible for Free School Meals, the more vital funding the school will receive to support children's learning and well-being.

The supermarket voucher will be sent via email to a child's primary parent (this is the parent registered as first contact on the school email system) and will be received by the start of the holiday.
