Please wait at the Paynesville Ferry terminal at the displayed Raymond Island departure time to assist with safe boarding and timely departures.

CONDITIONS OF USE: Follow instructions of the ferry operator at all times • Cyclists to dismount before boarding • Skateboards not to be ridden • Dogs permitted on a lead • Consumption of alcohol not permitted • Smoking not permitted
